The most important thing about the RESPA contract is that it guarantees your rights, wages, benefits, and working conditions as a classified employee in the district. While many articles are vital, the most crucial parts for everyday understanding and protection are:

- Article 12 Employee Protection and Rights
- Articles 6 & 7 Pay, Allowances, and Health & Welfare Benefits
- Article 8 Leaves
- Article 19 Grievance Procedure

Knowing your contract:

- Empowers you to advocate for yourself and others.
- Helps you get what you are owed.
- Provides a safety net in case something goes wrong
